

Electronic Health Information Export – Documentation

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1. Overview

Yasasii EHR 7 is SLI Compliance certified EHR and complying each certification criteria outlined in (b)(10) Electronic Health Information (EHI) Export. As part of EHI Export EHR user can perform data export operation for single as well as bulk patients given the access rights. Authorized user will be able to generate Clinical Care Document for single patient or patient population based on the mode of operation.

This application facilitates the export of Electronic Health Information (EHI) for both individual patients and patient populations in the following formats:

A. C-CDA:

Yasasii can export both single patient and a patient population via C-CDA standard and in accordance with the standards specified in HL7 CDA[®] R2 IG: C-CDA Templates for Clinical Notes R2.1 Companion Guide. EHR user can export EHI without any technical/developer assistance from the EHR.

B. Excel/PDF:

EHI, including patient clinical information, is exportable in the aforementioned formats. EHI encompassing additional details such as Patient Documents, Scheduling & Appointments, and Billing & Financial information is exportable via Excel and PDF file formats. Patient documents, including lab results, radiology reports, and any other scanned/imported/faxed documents, are exportable in PDF format. Galaxy is equipped to export scheduling and appointment information in both Excel and PDF formats. Lastly, the majority of billing and financial information is exportable in Excel format, with a portion also available for export in PDF format.

2. Export Options

Yasasii EHR offers EHI export functionality by following means -


• Patient Data Export: User can request access to EMR module and configure single/bulk export of patient data. Patients EHI can be exported using Export option as shown in image below.

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For rights to export specific feature Yasasii EHR user can raise request for grants to specific export functionality and given the access user can perform the operation.
